

#### I. Certificate of Need Program

A. <u>AL2013-017A, The Jacobs House I SCALF, Hayden, AL</u>: Proposes to add eight specialty care assisted-living beds to the existing 16-bed specialty care assisted-living facility, pursuant to the amendment to Rule 410-2-4-.04(2)(d)(6)(ii) of the Alabama State Health Plan. Opposition: None
