We draw your attention to the latest industry developments, news from local governments to Capitol Hill, grant opportunities, and upcoming events.

This month, we would like to congratulate our client <u>RockPort Capital</u> <u>Partners</u> for leading a <u>\$10</u> million Series A investment in FirstFuel Software. <u>Inc.</u> First Fuel, based in Lexington, Mass., applies deep analytics to building energy consumption data, hourly local weather data, and GIS building data to produce complete building analysis and energy savings. The result – an interactive Remote Building Assessment – provides a benchmark for building end-use energy performance, customized operational and retrofit recommendations, and monitoring and verification of energy savings over time.

On Capitol Hill, the administration promoted energy-related matters in the third week of February while Congress was in recess for the Presidents' Day holiday. <u>While speaking to college students in Miami February 23</u>, President Obama criticized the pro-drilling approach of Republicans and the reluctance of the oil and gas industry to relinquish its rights to \$4 billion a year in tax breaks, which the President has called for zeroing out in his fiscal year 2013 budget request. Separately, the administration acknowledged that gas prices are rising faster and earlier this year than ever before and is using this issue to remind Americans that developing clean, alternative energy sources is critical. Also, after two years of speculation, Treasury Secretary Timothy Geithner last week unveiled the administration's <u>proposal for tax reform</u>. Among other provisions, including reductions in the corporate and manufacturing tax rates, the proposal would make the tax credit for the production of renewable electricity permanent.

We are excited to support the New England Clean Energy Council in its inaugural <u>Clean Energy Day at the Massachusetts State House</u> scheduled for March 13. Clean Energy Day is a unique opportunity for Massachusetts businesses to highlight innovative technologies, connect with industry colleagues, and meet with their representatives and other important energy policy makers during a critical time of year for energy policy. Also, for our readers involved in the waste-to-energy business, we would encourage you to attend the <u>4th Annual Waste to Energy Development and Finance Summit</u> taking place in Chicago from March 27-29. Our very own Audrey Louison will be participating on two panels at this event: one addressing commercial and industrial waste generator perspectives on waste energy products, and the other, offtakers' perspectives on acquiring energy from waste to energy. We are also looking forward to attending <u>CERA Week</u> in Houston from March 5-9 and the <u>MIT Clean Energy Conference</u> from March 16-17.

## Mintz Levin's Monthly Incubator Profile

The second class of companies to enter <u>Greenstart's</u> accelerator program may be indicative of a broader trend in the energy startup business, <u>Xconomy reports</u>. Though we used this space last month to announce the graduation of the San Francisco-based accelerator's first class of companies, it's worth taking a closer look at its picks for this second round. The five companies selected focus on arranging shared transportation (<u>RidePal</u>); auditing the energy usage of commercial buildings (<u>KWhOURS</u>); software and services for managing urban commuting (<u>Scoot Networks</u>); automated demand-response software for small and midsized companies (<u>Smart Grid Billing</u>); and controlling the flow of energy in smart-grid environments (<u>Growing Energy Labs</u>).

There is a noticeable lack of energy generation technology prospects in this group and it appears Greenstart is betting entirely on software startups. Indeed, co-founder Mitch Lowe confirms that the accelerator has narrowed its focus to startups working at "the intersection of cleantech and IT." Lowe says "it's less about the development of energy and more about distribution and efficiency," and defines the four big areas of opportunity as the smart grid, buildings, transportation, and consumer services.
