

Reports: FMLA Regulatory Changes To Be Announced Later Today regarding Military Family Leave?

Various news outlets and web sites, including the <u>Washington Post</u>, <u>Fox News</u> and <u>MilitaryFamily.com</u>, have reported that the <u>Department of Labor</u> will propose various changes **today** to Family and Medical Leave Act regulations regarding military family leave. Fox reports that Secretary <u>Hilda Solis</u> will make the announcement with First lady <u>Michelle Obama</u>.

According to the web reports, the new rules will allow leave for family members when a servicemember is called to duty on short notice and "will help military families who require time off to care for service members who are injured or called to active duty."
