## U.S. Supreme Court Hears Oral Arguments in Kentucky Municipal Bond Case

The U.S. Supreme Court this morning heard oral arguments in *Kentucky v. Davis*, the case challenging the prevailing practice of states in the municipal bond marketplace of exempting holders of bonds of in-state municipal bond issuers from state income tax on the bond interest while taxing holders of out-of-state bonds on such interest. While questions at oral argument are not necessarily predictive of outcome, proponents of the constitutionality of such favorable tax treatment of in-state bonds found encouragement in the questions and comments of the Supreme Court justices for the proposition that the Court is unlikely to invalidate such state tax statutes. It remains unclear, however, whether the Court's decision, if generally favorable to existing state tax practices in this area, will draw a line that upholds such statutes for governmental bonds while requiring equal tax treatment for in-state and out-of-state private activity bonds that fund privately owned facilities. A more complete description and analysis of today's oral argument will follow later this week.
