State Legislatures Eye Al Regulation

For instance, Minnesota is studying how intelligence sharing with AI might enable law enforcement lead to civil liberty violations while North Dakota is considering how the technology could affect matters ranging from the job market to the 2024 elections. Perhaps leading the pack, Vermont released a detailed inventory of the AI currently deployed in its state government. More BVLOS Drone Operations Approved by FAA

Two more companies will conduct drone operations beyond visual line of sight (BVLOS). Recently, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) approved UPS Flight Forward and uAvionix for this type of operation in national airspace. UPS Flight Forward plans to conduct BVLOS drone operations for small-package delivery using a ground-based surveillance system. • Linn Freedman Recently Quoted in Modern Healthcare and SHRM News

Data Privacy + Cybersecurity Team chair Linn Freedman was quoted in the Modern Healthcare article "Increased cyberattacks lead to steep consequences for organizations" on August 22. In it, Linn spoke on the extensive impacts of cyber-attacks, saying, "You have to divert time and resources that you don't have to respond to this attack as a victim, and it takes you away from the good work that these institutions are doing."

Linn was also recently quoted in two articles published by the Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM): "Workers Duped by HR-Related Phishing Attacks" on August 15, and "QR Code Phishing Attacks Spread" on August 28. In the first story, Linn discussed how common phishing emails have become in the workplace, especially those that pretend to come from a company's HR department. "I have seen in practice that this is a particularly effective way to get people to click on things that they would normally not click on." The second SHRM article sources comments Linn made on the potential dangers of QR codes from her August 17 Data Privacy + Cybersecurity Insider blog "Privacy Tip," explaining that while people have become very comfortable with scanning QR codes, "it is important to understand that just like malicious code embedded in a link or an attachment in an email or text—which we have been trained not to click on—a threat actor can embed malicious code into a QR code with the same results."
