Please find enclosed a proposed stipulated order of settlement (the "Settlement") regarding claimant/defendant Christopher Ferguson ("Ferguson").


Pursuant to the Settlement, Ferguson agrees to forfeit certain property to the United States, including all funds in a particular account that is set forth in the Second Amended Complaint (the "Ferguson Account Funds").

Because at least one other claimant, Cardroom International, has arguably asserted a claim to the Ferguson Account Funds, the Government shall maintain the Ferguson Account Funds in a seized asset account until such claims are resolved.
