Will Athletes' Rights of Publicity Become Clearer in 2012?

Numerous pending lawsuits, including one brought by Manatt client Jim Brown, demonstrate that athletes' rights of publicity remains a murky area of the law. That lack of clarity is examined in an article by the Chair of Manatt's Sports Practice Group, Ron Katz, available here.

Presumably the confusion in this area of the law will lessen as decisions are rendered by the courts, some of which will likely occur in 2012.
