In the June edition of *Energy & Clean Tech Connections*, we've gathered recent information from a wide variety of sources in an effort to keep you abreast of what's new in the world of clean energy. We draw your attention to the latest industry developments, news from local governments to Capitol Hill, grant opportunities, and upcoming events.

This month, the Energy & Clean Technology Practice Group would like to congratulate Mintz Levin's client, PurposeEnergy, Inc. and ML Strategies' client Solar Trust of America. Based in Waltham, Massachusetts, PurposeEnergy addresses by-product and energy issues in the brewing industry with its Biphase Orbicular Biodigester System, which turns brewery waste into a clean-burning biofuel. Earlier this month, PurposeEnergy was selected as a "Brilliant Company" in Entrepreneur's top 100 ideas and innovators. On June 17, the third annual SolarDay, Solar Trust of America celebrated the groundbreaking of its Blythe Solar Power Project, a Department of Energy (DOE) loan guarantee recipient that, when completed, will generate enough electricity to power 300,000 homes. After the groundbreaking ceremony, Secretary of the Interior Ken Salazar applauded that just the first phase of the Blythe project will put 1,000 people to work during construction and create about 200 permanent jobs. In addition to the Blythe project, Solar Trust of America currently has 2,000 MW of solarenergy power plants in advanced stages of development throughout California and Nevada.

On Capitol Hill, the budget deficit talks that have dominated Washington for the last month remain at an impasse with Democrats insisting increased revenues be part of any final deal and Republicans reaffirming that tax increases would not pass Congress. In energy, the Obama administration and several Democratic congressmen have expressed opposition to four Republican bills intended to speed the development of renewable energy on public lands by allowing some projects to avoid National Environmental Policy Act requirements. The House Natural Resources Subcommittee has been presented with Democratic alternatives, one being a bill introduced by Rep. Ed Markey (D-MA) that would increase to 25% the percentage of electricity from renewables that the federal government is required to purchase by 2025. At the Subcommittee's June 23 hearing on these bills, representatives of environmental groups suggested the committee focus on providing financial stability for the renewable-energy industry through the extension of existing incentives such as a Treasury grant program.

Mid-July will be busy with events in Singapore, San Francisco, Boston, and North Carolina. <u>Clean Technology Investment World Asia 2011</u> takes place July 11–14 in Singapore, and <u>Semicon West 2011</u>, the flagship annual event for the microelectronics industry including semiconductors, photovoltaics, and LED lighting, takes place July 12–14 in San Francisco. Also July 13–14, the New England Clean Energy Council will partner with the Clean Economy Network with its <u>Washington, D.C. CEO Fly-In</u> involving high level visits and engagement with new congressional leadership. The following weekend, July 19–21, the <u>Green Data Center Conference Boston</u> will address corporate

Mintz Levin's Monthly Incubator Profile

This month we are profiling <u>Greenstart</u>, a San-Francisco-based venture incubator focused exclusively on clean tech. Greenstart was founded just last month by three veteran entrepreneurs and is already accepting applications for 8 to 10 slots in its first three-month program, scheduled to launch September 12, 2011. On similar terms to many Internet incubators, Greenstart teams will receive \$25,000 to cover expenses during the session in return for a 3% to 10% equity stake in the company. Teams will also benefit from comprehensive mentoring, networking, and a "graduation" from the program, which involves pitching to leading clean tech angel and venture investors.

Co-founder Mitch Lowe says the energy industry needs an early-stage startup accelerator much like those that gave many web innovators their first chance. One logical approach might be to have a separate solar accelerator, wind accelerator, efficiency software accelerator, and so on, to address the unique challenges facing facets of the broad clean tech space. Greenstart, however, is going to try to work across these categories by assembling a diverse mentor network and applying the nuances and approaches of other successful programs.

Greenstart expects its programs to be highly selective and cites access to its already <u>deep roster of mentors</u> from the clean tech and venture space as a key draw for applicants. The list includes Tesla co-founder Marc Tarpenning, venture capitalists Stewart Alsop, Jim Matheson, and Jeff Fagnan, former Flextronics CEO Michael Marks, and consultant Atul Vashista.
